 SHELTERING PROCEDURES In the event of an approaching bush fire threatening our school premises, our primary action is to SHELTER IN PLACE All occupants will be relocated and accounted for at our School Hall Parents/carers DO NOT COME TO THE SCHOOL we will be safely sheltering in place and keeping all staff and students calm through activities and games. If the threat is increasing it may be determined that it would be safer for all persons to evacuate to Kotara South Public School. If an EVACUATION is to occur we will: Immediately inform parents/carers via Skoolbag, Facebook or Dojo Safe transportation will be coordinated to relocate all persons to our designated evacuation refuge Information will be provided all parents/carers and arrangements will be made for the safe pick up of all persons from the designated evacuation refuge
