The school currently uses the Sentral software to record reports, behaviour, attendance etc and Sentral have a parent app that can be used to communicate all of the things that Class Dojo and Skoolbag do. It also allows for parents to view many things such as student attendance, interview booking and student reports online. The school has made the decision that starting next year we will use the Sentral Parent App and will no longer use Class Dojo and Skoolbag. The school will continue to use Facebook in 2021 to share good news stories with our community. We understand moving to a new platform may be daunting for some families therefore will post information on how to set up the Sentral Parent Portal in the coming weeks.

Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL)


**Weekly Focus**

This week we are revising the last three Awabakal words Nakila, Ngarala, Nubalin which mean look, listen and learn.
