



Dear families,

The P&C aim to keep uniform prices as affordable as possible and have absorbed all wholesale price increases for the past three years. However continued cost increases have made it necessary to review the prices of the school uniforms. The updated uniform order form is attached. Changes will be effective in the QuickCliq system at the beginning of term 4.

We are aware of the issue that families are experiencing with dye running in some shirts. We are working to source an alternative supplier and have made the decision to freeze a price increase on shirts until this is resolved.

There continues to be a selection of quality second-hand uniforms that can be purchased from \$2-\$5 per item. Please visit the uniform shop which is open on Thursday afternoon at pick-up.

Uniforms can be purchased through the QuickCliq system, or by returning a form to the school with cash or direct deposit details. Uniforms will be sent home with the selected student unless otherwise advised in the order.

We will offer a variety of experiences during the program including fort building. Children will use and develop a variety of skills - not just physical skills, but problem-solving, planning and social skills.
